Proposal for Supplement 1 to the 05 series of amendments to Regulation No. 105 (ADR vehicles)

Submitted by the Working Party on General Safety Provisions *

The text reproduced below was adopted by the Working Party on General Safety Provisions (GRSG) at its 101st session. It is based on ECE/TRANS/WP.29/GRSG/2011/35, as amended by the report (ECE/TRANS/WP.29/GRSG/80, paras. 30 and 31). It is submitted to the World Forum for Harmonization of Vehicle Regulations (WP.29) and to the Administrative Committee (AC.1) for consideration.

^{*} In accordance with the programme of work of the Inland Transport Committee for 2010–2014 (ECE/TRANS/208, para. 106 and ECE/TRANS/2010/8, programme activity 02.4), the World Forum will develop, harmonize and update Regulations in order to enhance the performance of vehicles. The present document is submitted in conformity with that mandate.

Paragraph 5.1.1.3.3., amend to read:

"5.1.1.3.3. The switch shall have a casing with protection degree IP65 in accordance with IEC Standard 60529."

Paragraph 5.1.1.6.3., amend to read (including the insertion of a new footnote $\underline{6}$):

"5.1.1.6.3. Electrical connections

Electrical connections IEC standard 60529 and be designed to prevent accidental disconnection. Connections shall be in conformity with ISO 12098:2004 6/, ISO 7638:2003 6/ and EN 15207:2006, as appropriate.

6/ ISO 4009, referred to in this standard, need not be applied.

Paragraph 5.1.2.4., renumber the reference to and footnote 6/ to read footnote 7/.

Paragraph 5.1.2.5., renumber the reference to and footnote $\underline{7}$ / to read footnote $\underline{8}$ /."
