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Proposal for supplement 23 to the 02 series of amendments to Regulation No. 7 (front and rear position (side) lamps stoplamps and end-outline marker lamp)

The present document is submitted in conformity with that mandate.



I. Proposal

Add new paragraph 5.8., to read:

"5.8. To obtain type approval according this Regulation is required possibility to install lamp in question at least on one type of vehicle according requirements of Regulation No 48."

II. Justification

1. Regulation No 7 does not contain requirements regarding the change of luminance of the lamps. It is possible to obtain a type approval for a lamp which cannot be mounted on a vehicle according Regulation No. 48. But such lamps could be used as aftermarket parts and could be installed on used vehicles. This proposal is intended as a protection against such situations.
