## Proposal for amendments to ECE/TRANS/WP.29/GRSG/2012/4 (Regulation No. 46 - Devices for indirect vision)

The modifications to the current text of ECE/TRANS/WP.29/GRSG/2012/4 (proposing amendments to ECE/TRANS/WP.29/GRSG/2011/23) are marked in bold or <u>double</u> strikethrough characters.

## I. Proposal

Paragraph 4.2., amend to read:

"4.2. Every device for indirect vision, with the exception of original Cameramonitor devices, shall possess on at least one of the main components its protective housing a space large enough to accommodate the approval mark, which must shall be legible when the device has been mounted on the vehicle; this space shall be shown on the drawings referred to in Annex 1. Other components of the device shall bear the name of the manufacturer and a means of identification. In case of limited **or no** space for the approval mark(s) **or when the approval mark(s) cannot be legible when the device has been mounted on the vehicle**, <del>other means of identification that link it to the approval number mark shall be provided</del> the provisions of paragraph 5.7 may be **applied as an alternative**."

## **II.** Justification

Document ECE/TRANS/WP.29/GRSG/2012/4 is based on informal document GRSG-101-03 unamended. The proposal above takes into account the discussions at 101<sup>st</sup> GRSG session to use provisions of paragraph 5.7. only in specific cases.

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
