## Proposal for amendments to Regulation No. 107 $(M_2 \text{ and } M_3 \text{ Vehicles})$

The modifications to the proposal GRSG-102-02 are marked in **bold** characters.

## I. Proposal

Paragraphs 10.24. to 10.26., amend to read (with insertion of a new paragraph 10.26):

- "10.24 As from the official date of entry into force of the 06 series of amendments, no Contracting Party applying this **UN** Regulation shall refuse to grant or refuse to accept **UN type**-approvals under this **UN** Regulation as amended by the 06 series of amendments.
- 10.25 As from 48 months after the date of entry into force of the 06 series of amendments, Contracting Parties applying this **UN** Regulation shall grant **UN type**-approvals only if the vehicle type to be approved meets the requirements of this **UN** Regulation as amended by the 06 series of amendments.
- 10.26 Contracting Parties applying this UN Regulation shall not refuse to grant extensions of UN type-approvals for existing types which have been issued according to the 05 series of amendments to this UN Regulation.
- 10.27 As from 60 months after the date of entry into force of the 06 series of amendments to this UN Regulation, Contracting Parties applying this Regulation shall not be obliged to accept, for the purpose of national or regional type-approval, a vehicle type-approved to the 05 series of amendments to this Regulation. "

## **II.** Justification

When revising the SDWEE proposal GRSG-102-02, the experts from the SDWEE informal group realized that the proposed transitional provisions do not follow the latest update of the guidelines (they were not available at the time the draft was issued) and may lack provisions for the extension of approval.

It is suggested to add such a paragraph which should follow the guidelines per document ECE/TRANS/WP29/2011/52 as revised by WP29.

The transitional provisions then would read (the added paragraph and the changes to the existing proposal per document GRSG-102-02 are in bold).
