## Proposed amendments to 5.4.1.1.18

#### Transmitted by the Government of Belgium<sup>1</sup>

## Introduction

1. The text of 5.4.1.1.18 now says that the additional inscription "ENVIRONMENTALLY HAZARDOUS" must be in the transport document for substances belonging to one of classes 1 to 9 that meet the classification criteria of 2.2.9.1.10.

2. In case of tank vessels, indication for the classification "ENVIRONMENTALLY HAZARDOUS" is already given by the abbreviations "N1, N2 or N3" – when applicable – as required by paragraph 5.4.1.1.2 (c).

#### Proposal

3. Amend the last sentence of the first sub-paragraph of 5.4.1.1.18 as follows:

"This additional requirement does not apply to UN Nos. 3077 and 3082, for the exceptions listed in 5.2.1.8.1 or for environmentally hazardous substances carried in tank vessels."
