The text reproduced below was prepared by the expert from the Russian Federation with the aim of aligning the English and Russian texts of the Regulation. The proposal concerns only the Russian text.

## I. Proposal

Amend paragraph 1.1.8 to read:

"1.1.8 Professional off-road tyres for the requirements on rolling resistance and rolling sound." [changes do not affect the English text]

# II. Justification

The proposal is aimed at ensuring that the English and Russian texts are equivalent. Paragraphs 1.1.1 to 1.1.8 of the Regulation contain exceptions in which the Regulation does not apply. Thus, in accordance with the English text, which is the original, professional offroad tyres **do not have to** meet the requirements for rolling resistance and noise emitted while rolling. The text was mistranslated into Russian.
