Draft amendment to document ECE/TRANS/WP.15/AC.2/2014/8 (EBU) - Adaptation of the reference to the standard for high velocity vent valves

Transmitted by the Government of Germany 1

1. The Government of Germany proposes to revise the transitional measure in 1.6.7.2.2.2 as follows:

| | | High velocity vent valves shall conform to the standard EN 12874:1999 on board vessels built or modified from 1 January [2001] [2009] or if they have been replaced from 1 January 2001. In other cases, they shall be of a type approved by the competent authority for the use prescribed. |

2. According to ADNR 2007, high velocity vent valves have to conform to the standard mentioned EN 12874:1999 from 1 January 2001 in the case of N.R.M. In ADN 2009, this applies in the case of N.R.M without indication of the date. There is no need to repeal this obligation *a posteriori* for the period 2001 to 2013.

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
