1. Adoption of the agenda

2. Advanced Emergency Braking Systems

The Working Party on Brakes and Running Gear (GRRF) may wish to consider proposals for amendments to UN Regulation No. 131 on Advanced Emergency Braking Systems (AEBS) taking into account footnote 5 in the table of Annex 3, if any.

3. Regulations Nos. 13 and 13-H (Braking)

(a) Electronic Stability Control (ESC)

GRRF may wish to consider proposals related to vehicle stability control, if any.

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(b) Automated Connections between Vehicles (ACV)

GRRF may wish to consider other proposals related to ACV or Modular Vehicle Combinations (MVC), if any.

(c) Clarifications

GRRF agreed to resume consideration of an updated proposal tabled by the expert from Germany to introduce new provisions for electro-hydraulic transmission for electric brake systems.
