Revised Pproposal ECE/TRANS/WP.15/AC.2/2015/2

<u>31</u>. Insert a new paragraph 7.1.4.4.4 to read as follows:

"7.1.4.4.4 <u>TheContainers with</u> electrical equipment <u>fitted to the outside of a close</u> <u>container may</u> are allowed to be connected with removable electrical cables <u>in accordance</u> <u>with the provisions of according to</u> 9.1.0.56 or <u>and to</u> be put into operation <u>provided that only</u> if:

- (a) <u>Such</u>The electrical equipment is of a certified safe type;
- or

(b) <u>Such an electrical equipment is not of a certified safe type Thebut</u>-source of ignition of the container is separated sufficiently from <u>other</u> containers containing substances of:

- Class 2 for which a label No. 2.1 is required in column (5) of Table A of Chapter 3.2;
- Class 3, packing group I or II;
- Class 4.3;
- Class 6.1; packing group I or II, with an additional hazard of Class 4.3;
- Class 8, packing group I, with an additional hazard of Class 3; and
- Class 8, packing group I or II, with an additional hazard of Class 4.3.

This condition is deemed to be met if no container containing the above-mentioned substances is stowed within an area of cylindrical form with a radius of 2.4 m around the <u>electrical equipmentsource of ignition</u> and an unlimited vertical extension.

This condition does not apply if containers <u>with electrical equipment</u> which <u>isare</u> not of a certified safe type and containers containing the above-mentioned substances are stowed in separate holds."

Examples of stowage and segregation of containers

<u>*R*</u> Container (e.g. reefer) with electrical equipment which is not of a certified safe type

Z Electrical equipment which is not of a certified safe type

<u>X</u> Container not allowed when containing dangerous substances for which sufficient separation is required

2. Insert a new 7.1.4.4.5

"7.1.4.4.5 The electrical equipement fitted to an open container may not be connected with removable electrical cables in accordance with the provisions of 9.1.0.56 nor be put into operation unless it is of a certified safe type or the container is placed in a hold which does not contain containers containing substances referred to in 7.1.4.4.4 (b)."

43. Consequential amendment: amend 7.1.3.51.4 to read as follows:

"7.1.3.51.4 The electrical installations in the holds shall be kept switched off and protected against unintentional connection.

This provision does not apply to permanently installed cables passing through the holds, to movable cables connecting containers, stowed according to 7.1.4.4.4, and to apparatus of a "certified safe type"."
