# Action Plan on implementation mechanisms of the provisions in the new Annex 9

#### Note by the secretariat

#### I. Mandate

- 1. The Working Party on Rail Transport (SC.2) at its sixty-sixth session was informed by the secretariat about facilitation of rail border crossings (ECE/TRANS/SC.2/2012/6). The Working Party suggested implementing monitoring mechanisms for the new Annex 9 of the International Convention on the Harmonization of Frontier Controls of Goods (1982) (Harmonization Convention).
- 2. The proposal subsequently made by the secretariat was adopted by the Working Party (ECE/TRANS/SC.2/218, paras. 52–54). The secretariat was requested to prepare a questionnaire for distribution to all UNECE member States which would identify and determine the current situation at rail border crossings in UNECE countries that are Contracting Parties to the Convention (taking account of the provisions of Annex 9 of the Harmonization Convention) and to prepare a background document action plan based on the replies to the questionnaire and on information received from different international organizations.
- 3. At its last session the Working Party was informed by the secretariat about replies to the questionnaire. This document (ECE/TRANS/SC.2/2015/6) is a proposed action plan on implementation mechanisms for the provisions in the new Annex 9 and is for consideration and discussion by the Working Party as follow-up to the questionnaire.
