
With reference to the UNECE's note of 2 December 2014 please be informed as follows: Under our guidelines for international agreements (RvV), art. 27 par. 2, international agreements are in principle signed on behalf of Germany by a representative of the Federal Foreign Office if necessary on the basis of full powers issued by the Federal President and in accordance with the required internal procedures. Germany presently does not see the need to conclude agreements as referred to in article 7 of the ATP Agreement.
