## Assessing the potential development of a list of chemicals classified according to the GHS

## Transmitted by the expert from the United States of America

- 1. The purpose of this paper is to call the attention of experts to a *Chemical Risk Manager* survey reported by ChemicalWatch.com.
- 2. It reported that of 46 responding, 96% believe that work should continue on the development of a classification list. Further, 45 respondents believed it would "simplify classification and labelling systems and management across countries," 28 believed that "it would improve safety through a better, common understanding of classification and labelling," and 13 believed that it would create "significant cost savings."
