List of publications for the biennium 2018–2019 for the Transport Subprogramme

Note by the secretariat

Summary

The Transport Subprogramme publications programme exemplifies our innovative analytical work, and impacts our regulatory work and policy dialogue, as well as our technical assistance and analytical work. Despite the value added of these publication outputs, the Subprogramme has been instructed to maintain in 2018-2019 the same number of publications as in the current biennium.

The Committee is **requested to consider**, **endorse and support** the list of publications for 2018-2019 contained in the annex.

The Committee is also **requested to consider** alternative ways to support the analytical outputs of the subprogramme that may emerge during the implementation of the subprogramme's work programme in 2018-2019.

1. The work of the Transport Subprogramme is based on three pillars: regulatory work and policy dialogue, technical assistance and analytical work. These pillars represent the core activities of the United Nations Economic Commission for Europe (UNECE) Transport Division. The Transport Subprogramme publications programme specifically exemplifies our innovative analytical work, although our publications, ultimately, impact all three pillars and are closely linked to the regulatory, norm and standard-setting activities. The quality of these publications demonstrates the Subprogramme's ability to be an analytical leader in the field of inland transport.

2. The number of publications produced within the Transport Subprogramme had been in a consistent, upward trajectory over the last biennium. However, due to the resource constraints, all UNECE Subprogrammes have been instructed to maintain the same number of publications in 2018-2019 as in the current biennium. However, it is possible that as a response to new challenges and opportunities in the implementation of the subprogramme's work programme, further publications may be warranted, subject to the availability of extra-budgetary funding.

3. The annex of this document provides the full list of publications. All analytical activities are either in support of accession to, or the implementation of, the legal instruments administered in the Subprogramme, or are essential for the performance of high quality technical assistance and capacity-building. To ensure that the results of these analytical activities are broadly used by governments and other stakeholders, the issuance of all reports and studies would be beneficial.

4. The Committee is requested to consider, endorse and support the preliminary list of publications for 2018-2019 contained in the annex.

5. The Committee is also requested to consider alternative ways to support the analytical outputs of the subprogramme that may emerge during the implementation of the subprogramme's work programme in 2018-2019.
