

Data Collection



- Web common questionnaire (with ITF/OECD and Eurostat)
 - Covers infrastructure, vehicle fleet and traffic levels
 - Road, rail, inland waterways, pipelines
 - Always open to receive data, but we now send reminders every Autumn
- Road accidents questionnaire to countries not covered by the CARE database
 - Very detailed breakdown (age, gender, road user etc.)
 - Data collected every ~2 years



Pilot Questionnaires



- Rail accidents collected in 2017 for 1st time, data will be published this Autumn
- Bus and coach pilot collected for 5+years, data will be published this Autumn
- Safety at Level Crossings sent out this Summer, results pending



Improved Data Disseminated Online



- Webcoq data now published ~3 times a year, last update in May
- Road safety data updated in July
- Many more indicators added, and dissemination cubes simplified in August




Two Main Publications

 - Latest version to be published in September








100,000 passenger cars	22








E- Censuses




- Unique international traffic censuses, providing comparable data on traffic flows on main European routes
- E-Road: For 2015, data received from 17 countries.
- E-Rail: Deadline for responses: July 2017.

CENSUS OF MOTOR TRAFFIC ON THE CZECH REPUBLIC E-ROADS IN 2016








Road Traffic: E-Road Census

White thickness indicates HGV %. We can see at a glance where the crucial goods border crossings are, and how much of border crossings is trade




TOR TRAFFIC ON THE CZECH REPUBLIC E-ROADS IN 2016







E-Road: Interactive European map








- Data available for 2005, 2010 and 2015, all shown on the map as layers










Glossary Revision

- Glossary first published 1994
- Covers ALL Modes
 - Infrastructure
 - Transport equipment
 - Traffic
 - Safety
 - Ancillary topics: economic performance, employment, energy consumption
- 4th Edition published 2009. We now need a 5th







Glossary revision process

- Informal Group of Experts established under WP.6
- Experts from 11 countries, covering most modes (not pipeline or inter-modal)
- Many international organisations taking part
- Collaboration starting now, with review of existing definitions and agreeing a roadmap, meetings to follow
- A long process expected
