### **Introductory note and AGENDA**

Trans-European North-South Motorway Project (TEM) was created to facilitate road traffic in Central and Eastern Europe and improve the quality and efficiency of transport operations, having in mind the need to balance existing gaps and disparities between motorway networks in Europe and further integrate European transport infrastructure systems. Furthermore, project promotes sub-regional cooperation in sustainable development, improvement of road safety and transport efficiency on TEM network.

Nowadays, aging infrastructure, increase of transport volumes and new investment in high-capacity roads on TEM network requires improved road construction and maintenance. There is a constant need to update road maintenance standards on TEM network and in TEM countries – sustainability, higher quality, cost reduction, lower environmental impact and better energy efficiency are just some of the requirements. Standardized maintenance activities and outputs, with implementation of state-of-the-art solutions, drive costs savings - one of the important parameters in time of economical restriction in national road budgets. Many TEM participating Governments keep those standards up-to-date, with clearly written down responsibilities, procedures and standards and this could serve as good starting point for preparation of the common and unified standards for TEM network.

The aim of the Workshop is to exchange best practices and prepare recommendation of Services levels and Key performance indicators for different road maintenance works.

Those recommendations will constitute a mile stone for preparation of the Report regarding TEM road and motorway maintenance standards in line with TEM Strategic Plan 2017-2021 Area C - Information systems for the management of the road infrastructure, task C1 – Maintenance standards for roads and motorways.
