(a) Work of the RID/ADR/ADN Joint Meeting

The Safety Committee may wish to consider the following:

The Safety Committee may wish to refer to the consolidated list of amendments to ADN adopted for entry into force on 1 January 2019 (ECE/ADN/45) which will be notified to ADN Contracting Parties on 1 July 2018.

Proposals for additional amendments aimed at bringing ADN into line with other international agreements on the carriage of dangerous goods, as well as corrections, resulting from the present session and adopted by the ADN Administrative Committee for entry into force on 1 January 2019 will be presented in documents ECE/ADN/45/Add.1 and ECE/ADN/45/Corr.1.

Proposed amendments have to be communicated to Contracting Parties no later than 1 September 2018 in accordance with the procedure outlined in article 20, paragraph 5 (a) of ADN, to ensure their entry into force on 1 January 2019, i.e. one month after acceptance by Contracting Parties.

Proposed corrections have to be communicated to Contracting Parties on 1 October 2018 at the latest (date of acceptance of the amendments in ECE/ADN/45) for acceptance in accordance with the usual procedure so that they can become effective by 1 January 2019.
