Proposal for Supplement 1 to the 03 series of amendments to UN Regulation No. 129

The present document is submitted in conformity with that mandate.

I. Proposal

Paragraph 2.3.2., amend to read:

"2.3.2. "i-Size booster seat" (Non-Integral Universal Enhanced Child Restraint System) is a category of Enhanced Child Restraint Systems with a maximum stature of 135 cm and with integrated backrest and stowable ISOFIX connectors if any, primarily designed for use in all i-Size seating positions of a vehicle."

II. Justification

- 1. At this moment the UN Regulation does not prevent the approval of an i-Size booster seat (Non-integral Enhanced Child Restraint System) up to 150 cm.
- 2. In order to keep the plug and play principle, it is necessary to clarify that an I-size booster seat (Non-integral Enhanced Child Restraint System) can accommodate children with a maximum stature of 135 cm.

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
