

Sustainable connectivity: sustainable networks

- Aviation: Single market -> Single European Sky
- **Road transport**: efficient, safe, secure and environmentally friendly mobility; fair competition; harmonising standards
- Rail transport: strong and competitive rail transport industry
- Maritime transport: preventing sub-standard shipping, reducing the risk of accidents, minimising environmental impact

 Inland waterways: strengthening the competitive position of inland waterways in the transport system
