Proposal to amend the text of UN Regulation No. 48

Paragraph 6.8.2. amend to read:

6.8.2. Number

Such that the device illuminates the site of the registration plate.

According to device type-approval documentation.

6.8.3. Arrangement

Such that the device illuminates the site of the registration plate.

Paragraph 6.8.4.1., 6.8.4.2. and 6.8.4.3. amend to read:

6.8.4.1. In width: Such that the device illuminates the site of the registration plate.

6.8.4.2. In height: Such that the device illuminates the site of the registration plate.

6.8.4.3. In length: Such that the device illuminates the site of the registration plate.

Paragraph 6.8.5. amend to read:

6.8.5. Geometric visibility

Such that the device illuminates the site of the registration plate.

II. Justification

1. The current text is in contradiction with requirements and parameters of the devices, which are determined in the type-approval process according to UN Regulation No. 4. Every type-approved device or pair of devices have their own geometrical position in relation to rear registration plate. It is determined due to luminance levels, maximum gradient value, angles of visibility and light incidence angle. There should be reference to these parameters in Regulation No. 48.
