- > State of Danger from 11 March
- Wearing of masks
- Social distance of at least 1,5 meters
- Vehicles maximum occupancy rate of 30%
- > Frequent disinfention
- > Humanitarian Corridors



Freight Traffic

- Free movement of goods, maintaining supply chains, with a priority for health care related goods.
- > Lifted weekend ban of heavy goods vehicles
- Free flow of goods in international air cargo and international povided in the second control of the second co
 - inland navigation
- > Rail freight without limitation




Gradual Re-opening
