Short-term vision and strategy

- General terms and conditions for Euro-Asian rail transport contracts (GTC EurAsia)
 - International private law model contracts (non-commercial)
 - To be prepared by industry (OSJD-CIT Legal Group)
 - Content: Liability, documentation, claims handling, compensation, etc.
- Inter-Governmental Document (IDG) (MoU, Declaration, Resolution,...)
 - Political support for GTC EurAsia (policy framework for Euro-Asian rail transport operations)
 - To be prepared by UN member States (cooperation with ESCAP)
 - UNECE Expert Group (to be established)
 - Content and scope (to be decided)
- Coordination + cooperation (UNECE, OSJD, OTIF, CIT)
