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## Proposal for Supplement 4 to the 07 series of amendments to Regulation No. 14 (Safety-belt anchorages)

## I. Proposal

Paragraph 5.1.5., amend to read:

"5.1.5. The angles  $\alpha_1$  and  $\alpha_2$  are respectively the angles between a horizontal plane through the point  $H_1$  and planes perpendicular to the median vertical longitudinal plane of the seat and passing through the **R-point** and the points  $L_1$  and  $L_2$ .

If the seat is adjustable, this requirement shall be fulfilled also for the H-points of all normal driving or riding position, as indicated by the vehicle manufacturer.

## II. Justification

The current text of Supplement 3 to the 07 series of amendments to Regulation No. 14 (Safety-belt anchorages) contains a scientific error regarding the establishing of the angles  $\alpha 1$  and  $\alpha 2$ . Furthermore an erroneous reference to a point "H1" is made which should read "R-point".

The Corrigendum rectifies these errors.
