EXPLANATORY NOTES

The Intergovernmental Working Group to draw up a legally binding instrument on civil liability for transboundary damage caused by hazardous activities, within the scope of the UNECE Conventions on the Protection and Use of Transboundary Watercourses and International Lakes (Water Convention) and on the Transboundary Effects of Industrial Accidents (Industrial Accidents Convention) was established by the Parties to both Conventions at their joint special session at Geneva on 2-3 July 2001 (ECE/MP.WAT/7 - ECE/CP.TEIA/5). Its first meeting took place at Geneva on 21-23 November 2001 (MP.WAT/AC.3/2001/2 - CP.TEIA/AC.1/2001/2), and its second meeting on 4-6 February 2002 (MP.WAT/AC.3/2002/3 - CP.TEIA/AC.1/2002/3).

At its second meeting, the Working Group invited its rapporteur and the secretariat to prepare a second version of a draft instrument (MP.WAT/AC.3/2002/4 - CP.TEIA/AC.1/2002/4) on the basis of the outcome of its second meeting.

The Working Group also invited delegations to submit working papers for consideration at the third meeting in addition to the working papers already submitted for the first and second meetings.

The Working Group is expected to set the indicative dates for its future meetings and decide on their venues. The secretariat has made preliminary arrangements for meetings to be held in Geneva on: 2-4 September 2002 and 11-13 November 2002.
