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# Challenges in setting targets



Targets have to be:

- based on countries' needs and priorities
- relevant for the current situation
- measurable and realistic
- established with the key stakeholders

Parties are expected to make provisions for public participation

# CH-Targets are set for...



- Access to drinking water
- Access to improved sanitation
- Monitoring of drinking water and waste water
- Best practices to the management of water supply and sanitation
- Protection of groundwater

# Targets more complicated to document (or neglected)



- Performance of collective systems
  - Drinking water suppliers
  - Sanitation
- Surveillance of water related diseases
- Recreational water
- Affordability to vulnerable groups

# Targets set and on going policies and strategies



- National water management strategy
  - Drinking water supply 2025
  - Water for the agriculture under climate changes
- Set the legislation for recreational water
- Sanitation: elimination of micropollutants

# Prioritization of the targets



Actual:

- a) Micropollutants, from agriculture, industry and consumers
- b) Performance of waste water treatment plants
