

 Many sectors involved






- **Objectives / expectations** to contribute to:

 - RBM planning










Workshop

- Key intersectoral linkages identified
- Reconciling different uses –
 potential solutions discussed
- Scenarios discussed
 - **Hydropower** development
 - Climate change
 - Agriculture expansion





- Ongoing / further steps
 - Data collection
 - Using already available data as much as possible
 - Consultation with national experts
 - Analyses and (limited) quantification (KTH + JRC)
 - Preparation of the draft assessment
 - Review of the draft assessment
 - Endorsement by the Task Force
