

## **Information sharing by Parties**

1. A representative of the European Commission informed about recent developments of common interest, notably the European Green Deal and the ongoing work on a Zero Pollution Action Plan including upcoming public consultations. She briefed about: (i) a recent report on the implementation of the National Emission Ceilings Directive; (ii) an upcoming Clean Air Outlook report; (iii) the progress on evaluation and revision of the Industrial Emissions Directive; (iv) an initiative with the Joint Research Centre on agriculture emission inventories; (v) the recent translation into Russian of the EMEP/EEA Guidebook; and the progress on monitoring of air pollution impacts on ecosystems according to the obligations in the National Emission Ceilings Directive.
2. A representative from the Department for Environment, Food and Rural Affairs (United Kingdom) presented the outcomes from the United Kingdom Air Quality Expert Group's Call for Evidence into the impact of Covid-19 on air pollution concentrations and exposure in the United Kingdom. In addition, some preliminary analysis was presented to show the potential impact of Covid-19 and lockdown measures on 2020 emissions across a number of key sectors.
3. A representative of Italy provided information on national work related to adverse effects of air pollution. The presentation could not be delivered during the session due to technical problems but is available at the sixth session's website.
