Revised mandate for permanent activities

- Development and publication of National Ammonia Codes (NAC)
- Dissemination of the ECE Framework Code
- Periodic update the ECE Framework Code with collaboration of national focal points to support its implementation.
- Inform and promote the use of nitrogen budgets
- Effects of human diets on nitrogen use and emissions
- Provide nitrogen-use indicators (incl water quality)
- Provide support to TFRN, TFEIP, TFTEI.
- Encourage ratification and implementation of the Convention and its protocols
