Course of Procedure

- Autumn 2009: Submission of the application for the zoning procedure
- End of 2009: Pre-Scoping
- June 2010: Espoo-Notification
- August 2010: Scoping-Session: discussion and gathering of additional suggestions and proposals
- October 2010: Information on the Probable Scope of Examination; decision on a future Scoping-Session in 2011
- December 2010: Presentation of Developer's Documents



Current developments

- Since Autumn 2010:

Development of
the EIA-Documents

- Delay due to investigation
work of the developer:

next Scoping-Session
approx. end of 2011





In the process

- Coordination and close collaboration of Danish and German Espoo-authorities and the developer
- Ministry of Economic Affairs Schleswig-Holstein introduced a non-governmental dialogue between planning authorities, the Ministry as well as NGO's
- Results of the “Dialogforum Fehmarnbeltquerung” will not be binding but shall be considered by developer and authorities
