
Iberdrola Renovables Offshore Deutschland GmbH, Berlin applied on 27.12.2010 according to the Marine Facilities Ordinance (Seeanlagenverordnung) for the Offshore-Windparks "Wikinger Nord" (8 turbines) und "Wikinger Süd" (18 turbines).

Both projects are planned in the exclusive economic zone of Germany roughly 35 km north-east of Rügen. Both projects are situated in a priority area for offshore windenergy according to the Maritime Spatial Plan for the German EEZ in the Baltic sea, which was set into force on 19.12.2009.

DK, SWE and PL have been notified according Espoo convention; PL wants to take part in the procedure, no answers from DK and SWE.

A scoping hearing will take place on 03.11.2011 to which stakeholders have been invited. The scope of the Environmental Impact Assessment report, which has to be handed in by the applicant, will be discussed.


