


Central Asian Leadership Programme, 11 years, 2010-2020

- Despite the challenges the COVID-19 pandemic brought, we collected on the ZOOM platform **46 young leaders from Central Asia and Afghanistan**, and about **70 exceptional speakers** from all around the world.
- In the light of the global pandemic COVID-2019, there is **an immediate need for an urgent recovery of economies, the environment**, and adaptation to the new challenges in relation to the health and education systems.
- The 11th demonstrated to the 11th CALP participants **not only the problems posed by the pandemic, but discussed the window of opportunities.**
