UNECE Convention on Industrial Accidents

Clearly Defined Scope

ASSISTANCE PROGRAMME

Article 2.1

This Convention shall apply to the prevention of, preparedness for and response to industrial accidents capable of causing transboundary effects

HIGH LEVEL COMMITMENT MEETING

Articles 1(a) and 1(b)

Geneva, 14-15 Dec 2005 (a) Industrial accident means an event resulting from an uncontrolled development in the course of any activity involving hazardous substances......

(b) Hazardous activity means any activity in which one or more hazardous substances are present or may be present in quantities larger than the threshold quantities listed in Annex I and which is capable of causing transboundary effects......

Identification and Notification

Article 4.1

For the purpose of undertaking preventive measures and setting up preparedness measures, each Party shall take measures, as appropriate, to identify hazardous activities within its jurisdiction and to ensure that affected Parties are notified of any such proposed or existing activity.

Owner Responsibility and Government Control

Article 3.3

The Parties shall ensure that the operator is obliged to take all measures necessary for the safe performance of the hazardous activity and for the prevention of industrial accidents......

Article 17.1

Each Party shall designate or establish one or more competent authorities for the purposes of this Convention...

Emergency Preparedness / Public Participation

Article 8.2

Each Party shall ensure for hazardous activities the preparation and implementation of on-site contingency plans...

Article 8.3

Each Party shall ensure for hazardous activities the preparation and implementation of off-site contingency plans...

Article 9

Each Party shall ensure that adequate information is given to the public in the areas capable of being affected by an industrial accident...

Accident Notification / Mutual Assistance

Article 10.2

In the event of an industrial accident with transboundary effects, the Party of origin shall ensure that affected Parties are ... notified through the industrial accident notification systems...

Article 12.1

If a Party needs assistance in the event of an industrial accident, it may ask for assistance from other Parties ...

Article 17.2.

Each Party shall designate or establish a point of contact for the purpose of industrial accident notifications and mutual assistance...
