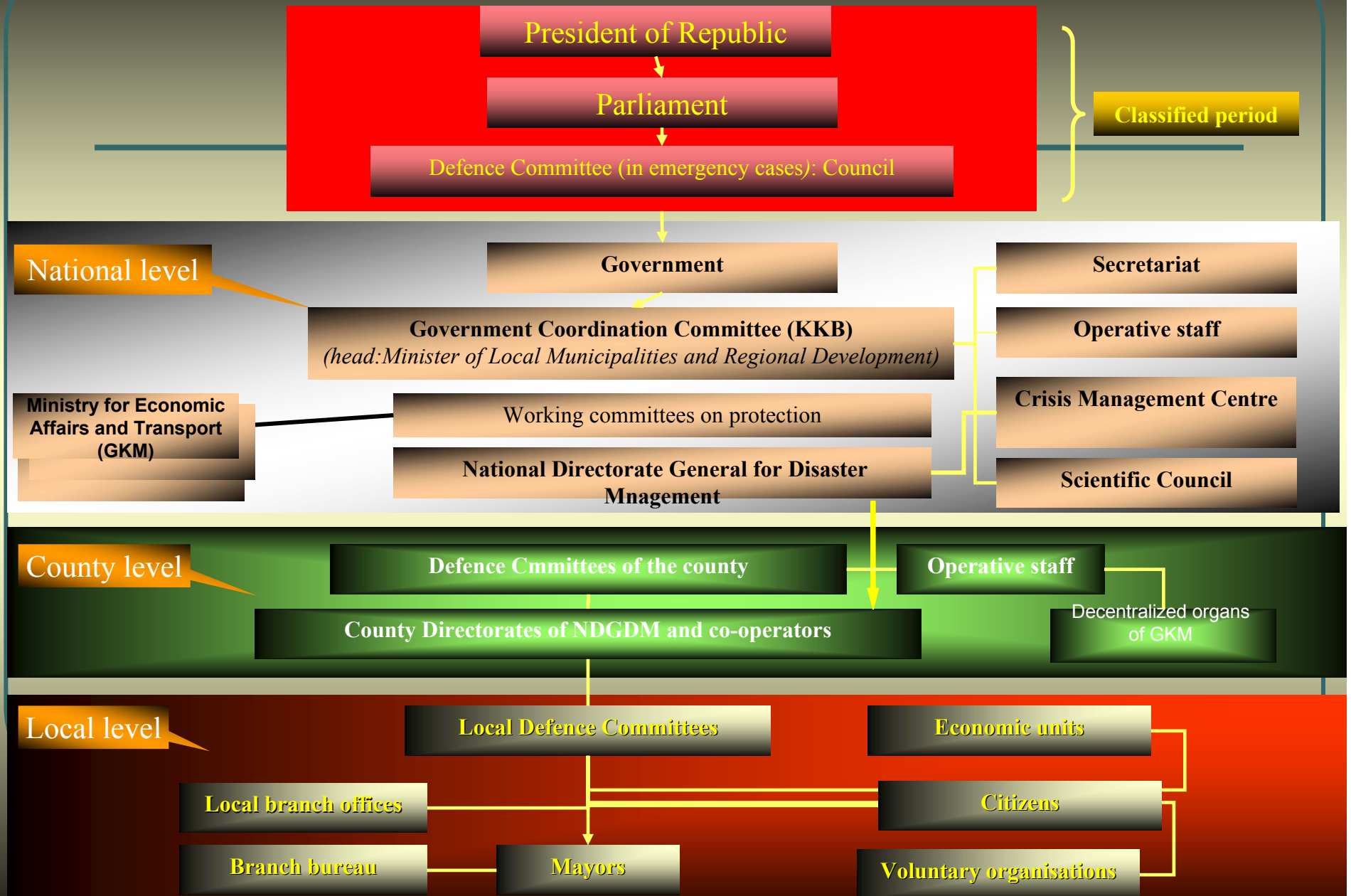

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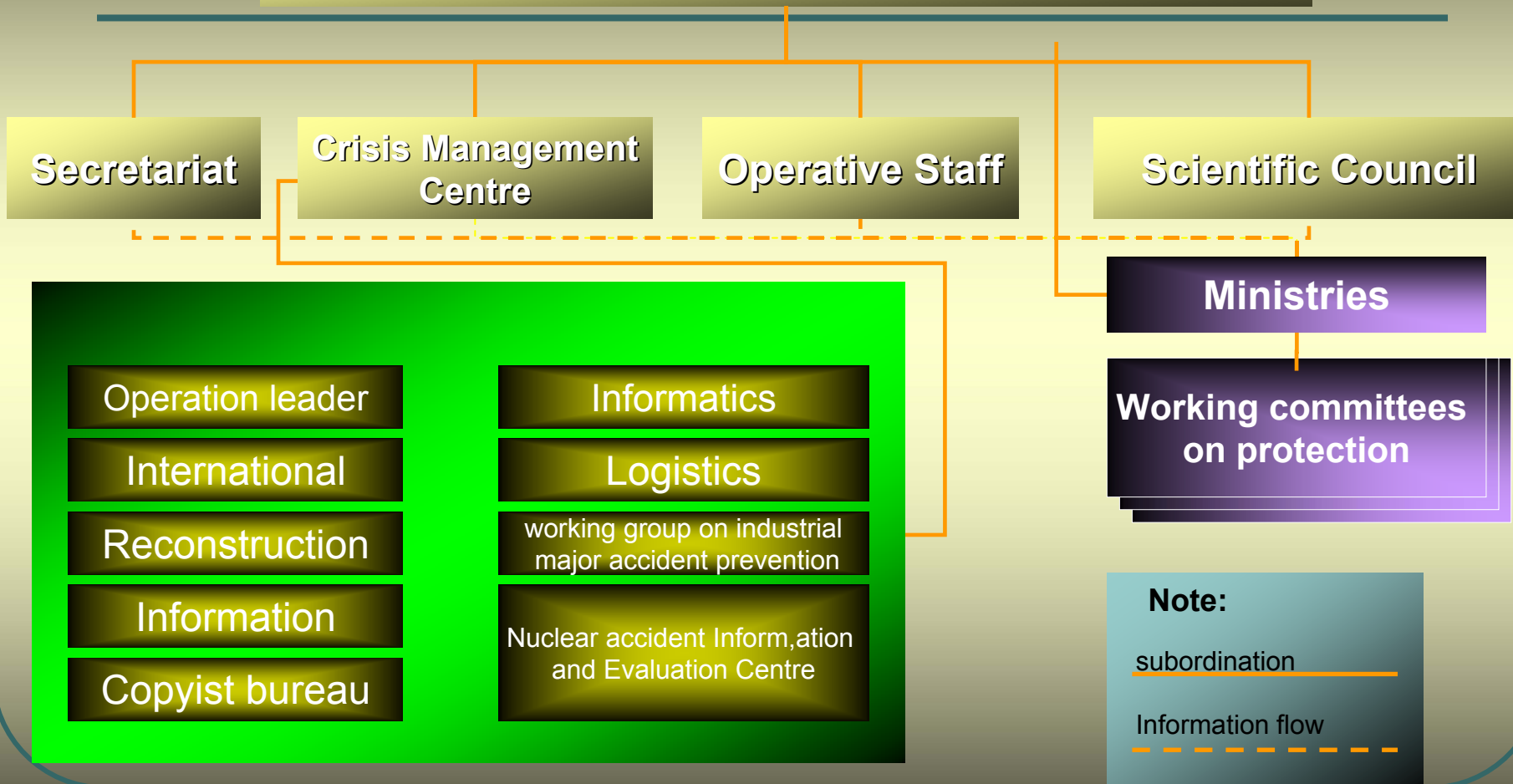


Direction system of national disaster management

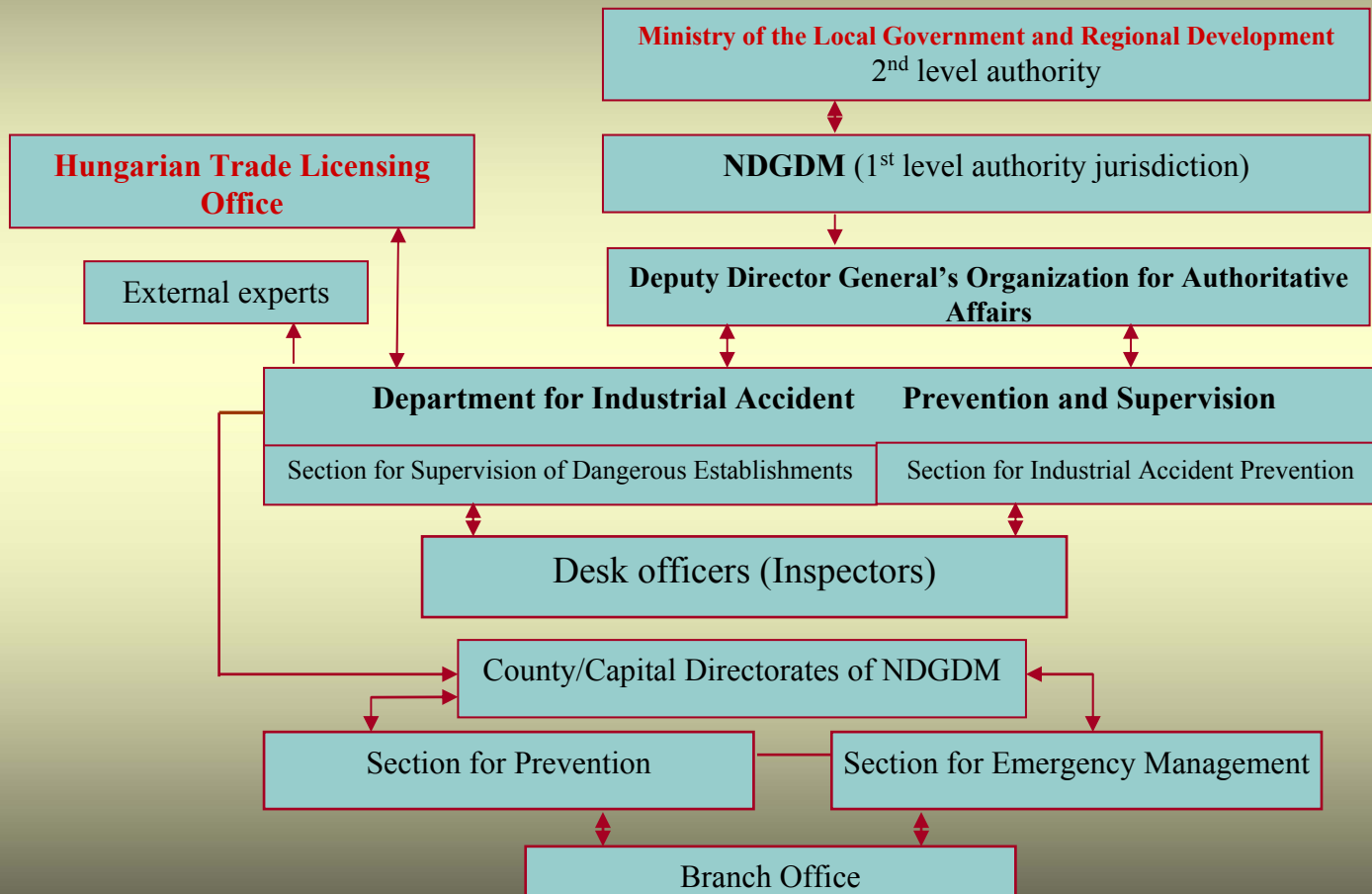

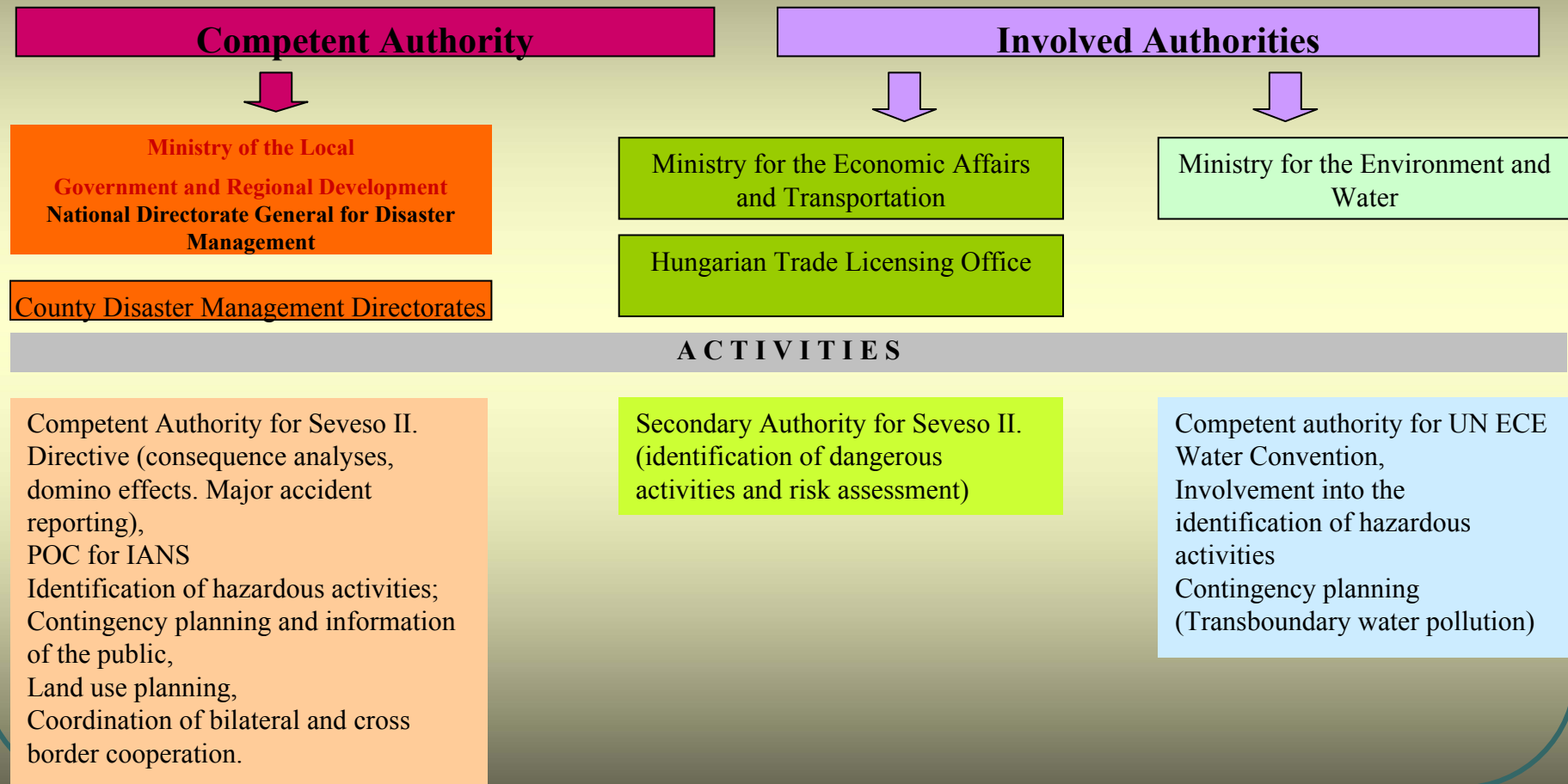

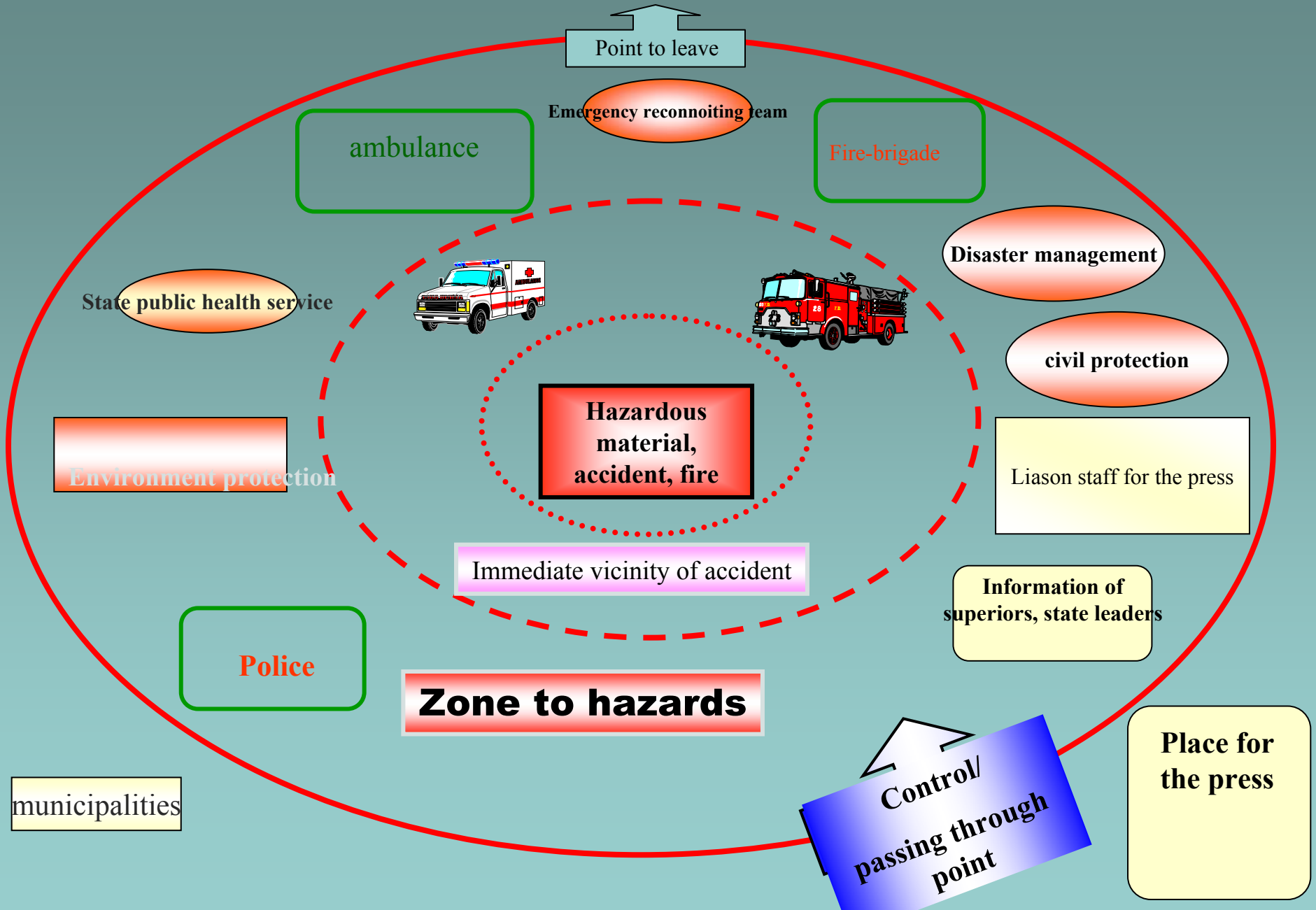

Regulatory background

- On behalf of Hungary regarding to the „Convention on the TransBoundary Effects of Industrial Accidents
- Signature: 18 March, 1992
- Ratifying, approving: 2, June 1994
- Notification of approval was deposited with the Depositary: 19of April, 2000:
- Entry into force: 1 of January, 2002.
- Government Decree No. 128/2001. (VII. 13.) on the announcement of the United Nation Economic Commission for Europe Convention on the transboundary effects of industrial accidents, signed in Helsinki on 17. March 1992.

- **Act LXXIV of 1999 on the management and organization for the protection of disasters and the protection of major accidents involving dangerous substances and Act VIII of 2006 on the amendment of it (Chapter IV)**
- **Act XXXI of 1996 on the protection against fire and technical rescue work and the Fire-service**
- **Act XXXVII of 1996. on civil protection**
- **Government Decree No. 179/1999.(XII.10.) on the execution of Act LXXIV of 1999 on the management and organization for the protection of disasters and the protection of major accidents involving dangerous substances**
- **Government Decree No. 18/2006. (I. 26.) on the response to major-accidents involving dangerous substances**

- **Order No. 48/1999. (XII.15.) of the Minister of Interior on the disaster protection tasks of organs subordinated to the Minister of Interior, the order of implementation of protection and the direction and operation of these organs**
- **Government Resolution No. 2408/1995. (XII.20.) on the Industrial Accident Prevention Regional Coordination Centre and National Centre shall be established in the frame of Convention on the TransBoundary Effects of Industrial Accidents**
- **Instruction No. 24/1999. (I. 15.) of the Minister of Interior on the process of duty system**
- **Annex 6 of Order/Measure of the General Director of National Directorate General for Disaster Management No. 27/2006 on the process of reception and forwarding of international and national information concerning to the transBoundary effects of industrial accidents**

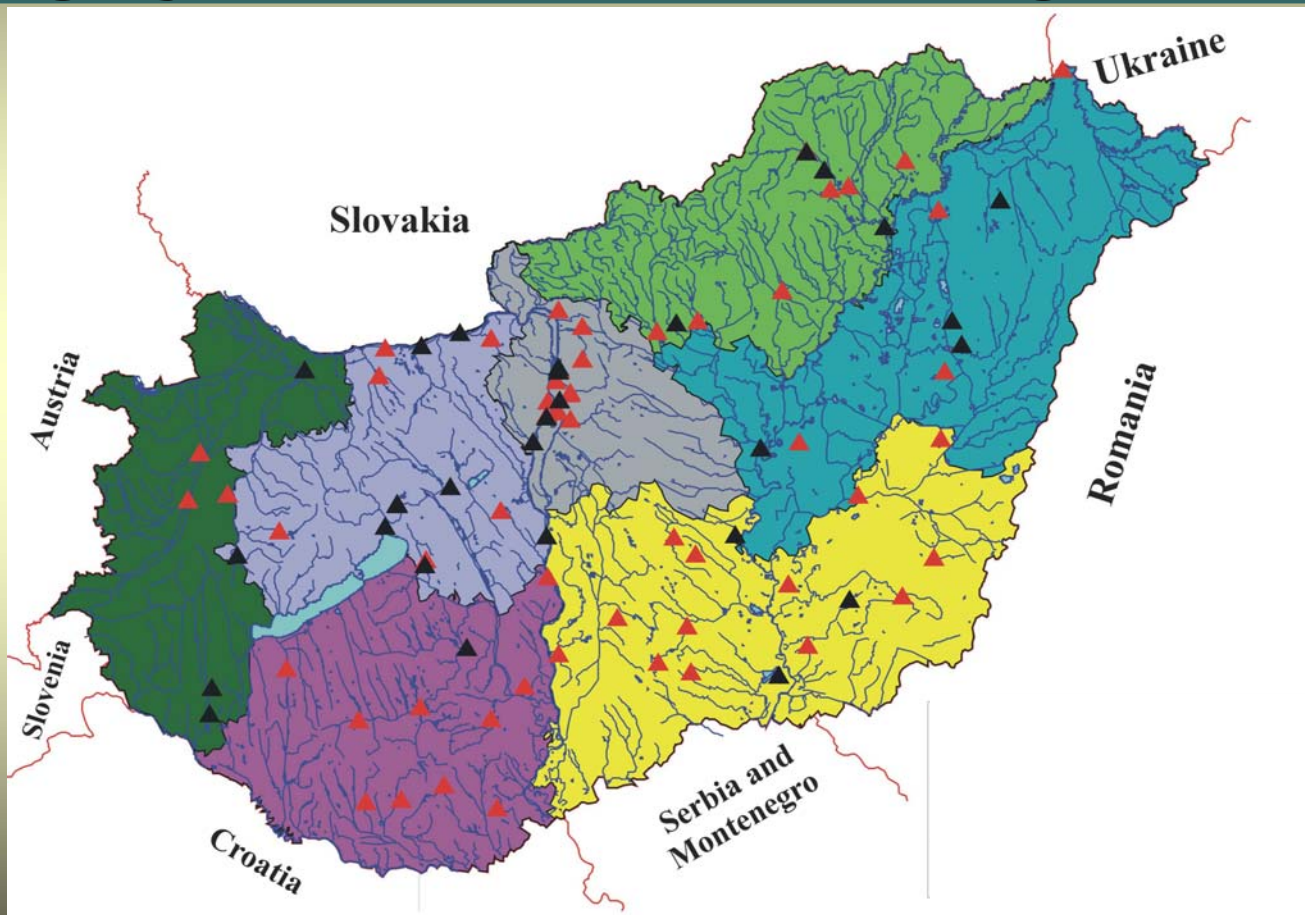

- **Government Decree No. 150/1995. (XII. 12.) on the announcement of the convention established regarding to the protection of natural and civilian disasters between the Government of the Hungarian Republic and the Government of Slovenian Republic**
- **Government Decree No. 212/1997. (XII. 1.) on the announcement of the convention concerning to the cooperation and mutual assistance in case of disasters between the Government of the Hungarian Republic and the Government of Slovakian Republic**
- **Government Decree No. 114/1998. (VI. 11.) on the announcement of the convention signed in Budapest, on 9 of July, 1997 on the protection of natural and civilian disasters between the Government of the Hungarian Republic and the Government of the Croatian Republic**



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Regulatory background

Bilateral agreements

- **Act CXII of 1999 on the announcement of the convention concerning to the mutual assistance in case of disasters or serious catastrophes between the Government of the Hungarian Republic and the Government of the Austrian Republic**
- **Act IX of 2000. on the announcement of the convention signed in Budapest, on 27 of October, 1998 regarding to the cooperation and mutual assistance concerning to the prevention and mitigation of consequences of disasters and major accidents between the Government of the Hungarian Republic and the Government of the Ukraine**
- **Act LXXXI of 2004 on the announcement of the convention signed in Budapest on 9 of April, 2003 on the cooperation and mutual assistance in case of disasters between the Government of the Hungarian Republic and the Government of Romania**



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Other forms of information exchange between neighbouring countries

- **borderland regional agreements regarding to cooperation between disaster management directorates, organs or local municipalities**
- **joint committiees of agreements in relation with environment and nature protection**
- **mutual joint visit**
- **Organisation of cross border emergency response exercise**
- **Participation on professional training sessions, workshops**
- **Parties to the Convention take the hazardous effects of hazardous industrial establishments into consideration while preparing their own external protection plan and informing to their public, during the permitting process of building of a new hazardous establishment, and through planning of land use**
- **Notification exercise quarterly**

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Reception of notification from abroad in case of an industrial accident

- the officer on duty shall receipt by fax the warning message/report in foreign language and shall interpret it
- shall inform the head of Prevention of Major Industrial Accident and Supervision Department on the reception of the message/report who shall propose by the data and information he possesses for the officer on duty measures to do, or applying of the working group for major industrial accident of the Crisis Management Centre or employing experts from the Prevention of Major Industrial Accident and Supervision Department
- alarming and informing of the appointed experts who evaluate the possible extent and weight of major industrial accident and the effects of of it on inhabitants home and abroad (situation evaluation)
- in addition to the above the officer on duty shall send the information and notification by the information order regarding to the management of emergency situation of the Duty Centre and regarding to the operation order of the working group for major industrial accident of the Crisis Management Centre
- the appropriate form of reporting shall be filled in by the situation evaluation and the measurement of the head of Prevention of Major Industrial Accident and Supervision Department



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Forwarding notification in case of a national major industrial accident

- the officer on duty shall get information on the occurrence of a national major industrial accident or its direct threat in accordance with the information order regarding to the management of emergency situation of the Duty Centre
- after the interpretation of the event the head of Prevention of Major Industrial Accident and Supervision Department shall be informed who – in case of its necessity - - shall propose by the data and information he possesses for the officer on duty measures to do, or applying of the working group for major industrial accident of the Crisis Management Centre or employing experts from the Prevention of Major Industrial Accident and Supervision Department
- alarming and informing of the appointed experts who evaluate the possible extent and weight of major industrial accident and the effects of of it on inhabitants home and abroad (situation evaluation)
- by the decision of the head of Prevention of Major Industrial Accident and Supervision Department the filling in and forwarding of the the appropriate notification form to the national and foreign organs concerned shall be executed
- in addition to the above the officer on duty shall send the information and notification by the information order regarding to the management of emergency situation of the Duty Centre and regarding to the operation order of the working group for major industrial accident of the Crisis Management Centre



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MoLaRi System

**Meteorological, chemical Monitor and Warning of inhabitants system
(MoLaRi)**

The system has 3 parts:

- **system of chemical monitor and meteorological ends**
- **communication and electronical data transferring system**
- **warning and information system of inhabitants**
