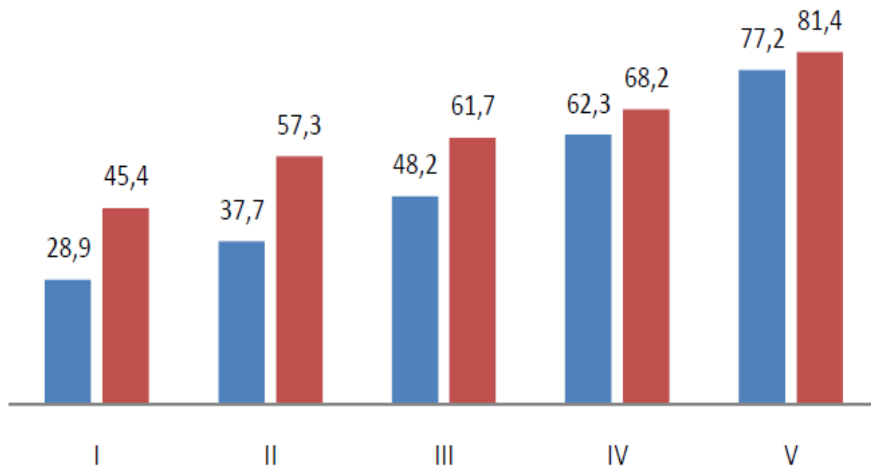
Equitable scorecard assessment:

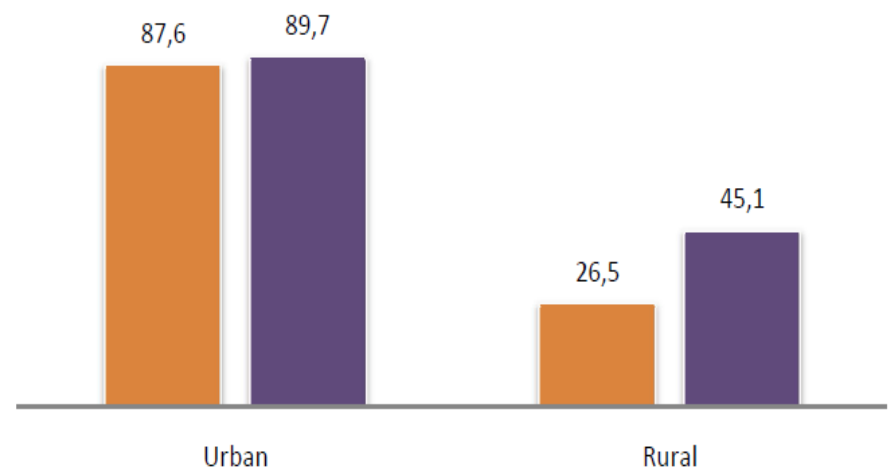
access to public water system - poverty status

access to public water system - urban/rural

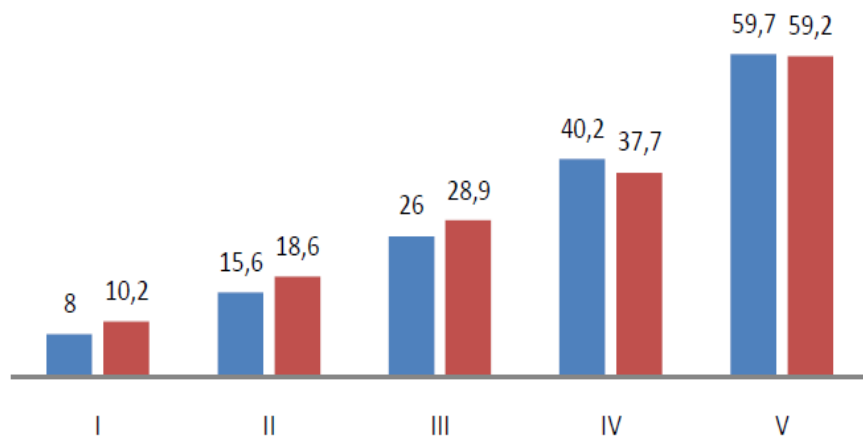

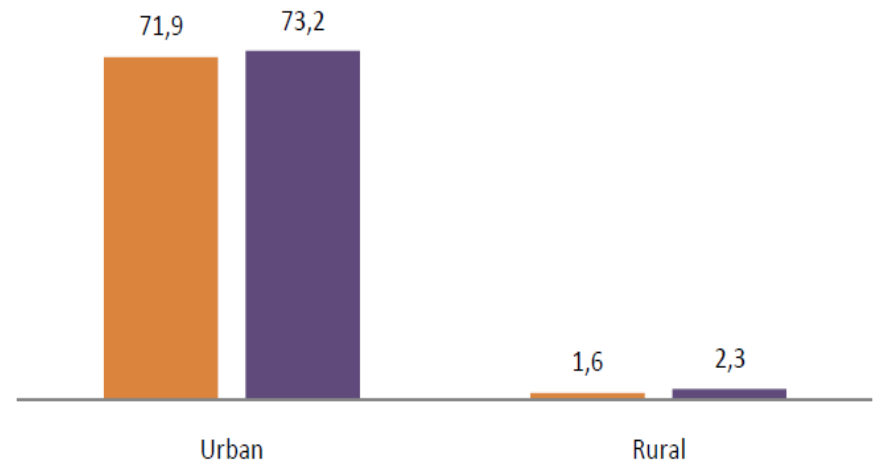
access to public sanitation - poverty status

Factors:

Financing increased (investments increased in rural areas)

2009 – 0,8% of national budget

2012 -3,1% of national budget

2013 – 3,8% of national budget
