Issyk-Kul lake

- Lake Issyk Kul has a length of 182 kilometers (113 mi), a width of up to 60 kilometers (37 mi), and covers an area of 6,236 square kilometers (2,407.7 sq mi), which makes it the second largest mountain lake in the world next to Lake Titicaca in South America.
- About 118 rivers and streams flow into the lake; the largest are Djyrgalan and Tyup. It is fed by springs, including many hot springs, and snow melt-off. The lake has no current outlet
- Administratively, the lake and the adjacent land are within Issyk Kul Province of Kyrgyzstan.





- Presentation of the project at local, national and regional level meetings




- Sub-global ecosystem assessment for Issuk-kul lake
