
The project: Vecht PES case study

- Phase I (2011): Very pragmatic, interview based approach to elicit central ES
 - Results consulted with water managers and other central stakeholders
- Main Outcomes:
 - ES seems to be a good approach for integrating perspectives
 - Promising for further cooperation
 - Now go for a specific PES scheme >>
- Phase II of the project in the Vecht basin (2012 2013): Developing a proposal for a regional scheme on payments for ecosystem services
