The Water Convention has served as a model and stimulated the work of transboundary Water Commissions in the UNECE region while the older Water Commissions formed a basis upon which the Water Convention has been built. Over the years, work aimed at protecting transboundary waters has evolved and has been faced with growing challenges and responsibilities.

The side event will allow sharing the experience gained under a number of European Commissions and discussing how progress has been achieved, the lessons-learned that can be replicated, and the challenges ahead.

A moderated panel discussion will analyse the responsibilities of river commissions, their strengths and weaknesses, and their role in preventing and addressing problems of transboundary water management. The panel discussion will aim to promote cross-fertilization between experiences and to inspire the work under other commissions in the UNECE region and under the Water Convention.
