






Excludes: Construction and Demolition, Mining waste


Million tonnes



- 6000 businesses surveyed
- 12 business sectors (6 Industrial)
- Face to face, telephone and HQ information
- 10 months to complete
- Cost around £1m (€1.2m)

Industrial waste breakdown






Industrial waste 2009, England




