



Forest Resources Assessment 2015 Questionnaire

- Seeks answers to 21 globally-significant forest resource questions
- Builds on the previous questionnaires (58% of all variables pre-filled from FRA 2010)
- New elements aim to learn more about:
 - reporting on growing stock
 - gross deforestation and degradation
 - progress towards SFM



UNECE/FAO FTS contribution to FRA 2015

- Preparatory process
 - AG, CFRQ, thematic workshops
 - 4th Meeting of ToS, Saint Petersburg, May 2012
- Data collection process
 - Coordination and assistance to 54 countries in their national reporting
 - Organization of the workshop for national correspondents, Geneva, October 2013
- Contribution to analysis of information and production of the final outputs

Status of national reporting

- national reports from 41 countries
- desk studies for 15 countries

Main outputs:

- FRA Desk Reference
- FAO Forestry Paper
- Special volume of a scientific journal




