
- Three Preparatory Committee meetings: May 2010, March 2011 and May 2012

#### **Process for outcome document**

- Inputs received from all, by Nov 1 at <u>uncsd2012@un.org</u>
- National and regional Prep meetings input
  - Bureau prepares a compilation document by Dec 15-16 intersessional
- Serves as basis for zero-draft by early Jan
  Discussion of zero-draft in 3 days meeting in Jan
  One week of informal informals in each of Feb, March and April to further discuss draft outcome

• Focused political document

 to address integration of economic, social and environmental goals,

• coherence of action at all levels, and

ensure implementation of commitments

- 4th session of the Meeting of the Parties to the Aarhus Convention, 29 June-1 July 2011, Chisinau, Republic of Moldova
- Steering Committee of the UNECE Strategy for Education for Sustainable Development at its Sixth meeting in April 2011, Geneva





#### **Preparations:**

- Invitations sent out to UNECE member states, relevant international org-s and major groups together with the provisional agenda
- A draft organization of work will be elaborated by the secretariat in cooperation with the UNEP, UNDP and other regional org-s and bodies
- Side events by governments, partner organizations, business, NGOs and civil society
- Training and Coordination Meeting for NGOs by DESA and Major Groups organizing partners, on November 30





#### Format of the meeting

- A 2-day meeting divided into **3 thematic segments**, organized in the form of multi-stakeholder panel discussions and round table, and a plenary session:
- **1.** Assessment of progress in the implementation of the outcomes of the major summits on SD and addressing new and emerging challenges
- 2. A green economy in the context of sustainable development and poverty eradication
- 3. The institutional framework for sustainable development
