Technical aspects

Achievements and current work



- **✓** eTIR system/software:
 - ✓ Fully implemented and tested according to the eTIR specifications v4.1
 - Implementing and testing the updates needed according to the eTIR specifications v4.2 and v4.3
- eTIR database: applied the most important changes that we had identified

Security / Reliability: increased the number of internal automated tests from 130 to 426

eTIR data model

Achievements and current work



- The TIR secretariat became capable to develop and maintain the eTIR data model
- Purchased (and trained on) the necessary software to maintain and further develop the eTIR data model
- ✓ Improved the processes to generate the documentation needed for the eTIR specifications
- Updating the eTIR data model to reflect the amendments approved by the GE.1
- Preparing multiple amendment proposals to be reviewed by the GE.1


