Uniform provisions concerning the approval of vehicles with regards to Automated Lane Keeping System

- Automated <u>Lane Keeping</u> System
- Highways*
- Maximum speed: 60 km/h
- Scope: Vehicles of category M₁
- Optional system (not mandatory)!

Speed increase up to 130 km/h



Lane change functionality

GRVA/2020/33

- Both proposals are independent from each other, but fit together
- Concept unchanged: ALKS (+ proposed amendments) is an optional system

Update of activities from Germany on working level



Internal review & bilateral exchange – some "findings"

Speed increase up to 130 km/h

- Clarifications,
- Editorial improvements, ...

Lane change functionality (incl. MRM)

- Clarifications,
- Consolidation requirements for regular lane change and in MRM condition,
- Target lane assessment: provisions for critical situation (values),
- Conditions/reasoning for lane change,
- Amendments for testing section,...

Separate functionalities or necessity to combine?

→ Suggestion to continue discussing separately on technical level first, then decide if 130 km/h should be coupled to lane change ability

New name for system?

→ Suggestion to keep as it is for the moment
