Project title and project number: Towards 2030: Strengthening mechanisms for peer learning, policy exchange and progress assessment on sustainable development in the UNECE region

## Expected timing/ duration: January 2020-31 July 2021

## Objective and brief summary of the project:

The project aims to strengthen the capacity of UNECE member States to implement the 2030 Agenda for Sustainable Development by providing an annual platform for peer learning and policy exchange as well as preparing an annual report to assess regional progress in implementing the Sustainable Development Goals (SDGs). The Regional Forum on Sustainable Development has proven to be a fastgrowing platform for practical peer learning on SDG solutions; the number of participants increased by more than $50 \%$ and the number of round tables tripled compared to the 2017's Regional Forum. The Forums mobilized governments from more than 50 member States as well as civil society, academia and international partners from across the UNECE region. The objective of the project will be achieved by implementing the following activities:

A1.1. Organization of the annual Regional Forum on Sustainable Development for the UNECE region, consisting of a high-level dialogue and thematic round tables to enhance peer learning and policy exchange among UNECE member States and other stakeholders, including civil society, the private sector and academia (concrete modalities to be determined by member States), in Geneva in 2020 and 2021;
A1.2. Organization and coordination of preceding meetings, including civil society and youth pre-meetings and side events, as well as preparation of follow-up contributions from the region to the high-level political forum on sustainable development;
A2.1. Preparation of an annual report to assess progress towards the 2030 Agenda in the UNECE region, including the assessment of regional trends, advances and gaps in the realization of the Agenda, using existing data sets and statistics.
A2.2. Preparation of the design of a web-based SDG Dashboard.

## Expected results of the project:

EA1. Enhanced policy dialogue and peer learning on sustainable development in the UNECE region by organizing the Regional Forum on Sustainable Development in 2020 and 2021;
EA2. Improved understanding of the UNECE member States of progress on the implementation of the 2030 Agenda for Sustainable Development with a focus on regional trends.

## Target group and beneficiaries of the project:

Target group: UNECE policymakers in areas related to sustainable development, other international organizations, civil society, business and academia. Beneficiaries: UNECE member States.

## Justification of project and its relationship to the programme of work:

At its $67^{\text {th }}$ session (26-27 April 2017), the Commission decided to establish the Regional Forum on Sustainable Development for the UNECE region, which, while retaining its intergovernmental character, would serve as a regional mechanism to follow-up and review the implementation of the 2030 Agenda for Sustainable Development (Decision B(67), E/2017/37, E/ECE/1480). At its $68^{\text {th }}$ session (9-10 April 2019), the Commission decided to continue to convene annual sessions of the Regional Forum in the years 2020 and 2021. The Commission also requested the secretariat to publish a yearly report on the implementation of the 2030 Agenda for the UNECE region (Decision B(68), E/2019/37, E/ECE/1488).
