

# NRP based on open source model – pros and cons

Advantages	Disadvantages
Acting in harmony with SDGs spirit	Limited flexibility (challenging to adjust to the specific needs)
Following the CES Road Map on statistics for SDGs	Technical knowledge required to further developments and customization
Friendly and easy for users; unified layout favors custodian agencies	Need for additional staff (including IT experts) to maintain and develop the platform
Easy to implement	Not possible to link data uploading with different data sources
Law costs
