



New needs \rightarrow Innovations \rightarrow

- Change in Data collection modes(e.g. CAPI→CATI,CAWI)
- Establishing new partnership
- Use of new data sources (e.g. big data, admin data), treatment and integration
- Experimental statistics









Rearranging plans of technical cooperation identifying the activities that can be carried on remote



Development of material to support the remote technical support \rightarrow longer preparation



Conversion some on site missions versus webinar/virtual workshop/online bilateral exchange/online training



Difficulties in working with data/data sharing (documents, evidence, info, etc.)



Wider audience by activity, more involvement of staff but less time (max 3 hours by slot)



Challenges

Investments on IT infrastructure, connectivity, platform to be used for remote activities

New skills for remote activity

Coordination of remote/on site activities (e.g. production of webinars on same topic)

Evaluation of impact of the activities, outputs,... monitoring system



Opportunity

More flexibility towards "mixed" mode in technical cooperation activities (online, onsite)

Involvement in some activities with a wider participation

More frequent Steering Committee by project (on site and remote)
