

- Web application for presentation and dissemination of statistical data
  - Developed by Statistics Sweden together with Statistics Norway and Statistics Denmark
  - Large community of organisations using PxWeb, 90+
  - Totally localized, any language can be used
  - Powerful web API for data retrieval
  - Support for multiple datasources
    - Database
    - PX-Files
  - Annual reference group meetings with participants from countries using PxWeb







Multi Dimensional Table
