Balance on 31 December 2019: US\$ 4,173,536


Provisional total contributions in 2020 (+): US\$ 3,962,687

Provisional total expenditures in 2020 (-): US\$ 2,974,093

Approximate balance on 31 December 2020: US\$ 5,162,130

Expenditures were lower than usual due to the Covid-19 pandemic and thus almost no travel

Conclusions and trends

- Very positive that some new Parties are contributing
- Still reliance on a few main donors, only 13 Parties contributed in 2020
- All contributions are useful and needed, also in-kind
- Some additional contributions are needed for this work programme, 2021
- Positive examples of unearmarked contributions
- Very positive that more and more contributions do not have separate reporting requirements => relying on Convention's reporting
- High reserve is needed for staff funding
