Dear Mr. Yagmyrov,

I hope you are well.

I refer to my letter of 2 March 2020 sending you the Committee's second progress review on request ACCC/M/2017/2 concerning Turkmenistan's compliance with articles 3(1), (4) and (9) of the Convention with respect to the possibilities for foreign citizens and persons without citizenship to found and participate in non-governmental organizations promoting environmental protection.

At paragraph 37 of in its second progress review, the Committee invited the Party concerned to provide a final progress report by 1 October 2020 on the measures it had by that date taken to address paragraph 35 (a) and (b) of the second progress review, including the text of all legislative measures it has by that date adopted to that end.

To date, the Committee has not received Turkmenistan's final progress report on request ACCC/M/2017/2.

In the coming weeks, the Committee will commence the preparation of its report to the seventh session of the Meeting of the Parties (18-21 October 2021) on the progress made by Turkmenistan to fully implement request ACCC/M/2017/2.

Accordingly, we would be grateful to receive Turkmenistan's final progress report as soon as possible, and at the latest **by 30 April 2020**.
