4. Policy work will also support the completion of the review of the Gothenburg Protocol as amended and consideration of the need for any future update of the Protocol. The Working Group on Strategies and Review is <u>also</u> expected to continue policy conversations on the hemispheric transport of ozone and particulate matter and their precursors, including a discussion of control strategies to recommend for use by the Task Force on Hemispheric Transport of Air Pollution in future scenarios.
