- Are published regularly
- > The most current data is from 2019 and this year the data for 2020 are disseminated
- Are useful for national planning, the National Catalog of Indicators and for the SDGs
- Include data such as the sectoral GDP, jobs, SUT, physical and hybrid indicators, among other variables
- In project: Ecosystem Accounts, Social Economy and Satellite Account for Fishing Sector
