## **International Certificate for Operators of Pleasure Craft issued by Ukraine**

### **Transmitted by Ukraine**

The State Service for Maritime and River Transport of Ukraine in accordance with the requirements of resolution No. 40, International Certificate for Operators of Pleasure Craft, has provided the following information on the issuance of the International Certificate for Operators of Pleasure Craft (ICC).

The competent authority for issuing of ICC in Ukraine is the State Service for Maritime and River Transport of Ukraine (Maritime Administration of Ukraine).

According to the national procedure, determined by Order No. 283 of the Ministry of Infrastructure of Ukraine dated 07.05.2013 (as amended), ICC are issued for such categories of vessels:

- (a) Sailing vessel:
  - Up to 6 m long and the sail area up to 12 m<sup>2</sup>;
  - Up to 8.5 m long and the sail area up to 30 m<sup>2</sup>;
  - Up to 15 m long and the sail area up to 80 m<sup>2</sup>;
  - Up to 24 m long and the sail area over 80 m<sup>2</sup>.
- (b) Hydrocycles irrespective of length and power.
- (c) Motor vessel:
  - Up to 6 ms;
  - From 6 to 24 m.

The Ministry of Infrastructure of Ukraine together with the Maritime Administration introduced a pilot project for the issuance of ICC in electronic format.

Digital documents fully comply with the requirements of resolution No. 40 regarding their form and content.

Digital documents are issued simultaneously with the hard copy. Both options are legitimate.
